



## **EDIA publishes 3 more volumes of the “Memórias D’odiana” collection**

There are now available to the public three new volumes of the second series of “Memórias D’Odiviana”, a publication dedicated to three projects of minimizing impacts on Archaeological Heritage, developed during the construction of the Alqueva Dam.

These publications appear after the publishing, on last September, of the first four volumes of a series of fourteen, in a partnership between EDIA, the company responsible for the management of the Alqueva Project, and the Alentejo Regional Direction of Culture.

We should recall that the construction of the Alqueva dam and the whole Project, with particular emphasis on the areas served by secondary infrastructure, irrigated areas, motivated the development of a wide plan to safeguard the Archaeological Heritage, an unprecedented process in Portugal. It origins that today existed more than 1500 archaeological sites that had been intervened.

Apart from safeguarding these archaeological remains, through their registration, one of the guidelines of the project entails the publication of the results of such work.

With these three new volumes is given continuity to the promotion of the results of the work done in the context of Alqueva project policy, giving to know to public a part of the history of the region.
